Update to Manvel City Hall Protocols

Manvel City Hall has changed its protocols and procedures as staff and council begin a comprehensive effort to combat the spread of COVID-19 in the community.

Beginning Monday 3/23 and for the following two weeks, City Hall will be open during regular hours, but no public access to the building will be allowed. The staff will be available by phone (281-489-0630) or by e-mail. Many city activities are available through the City's website (www.cityofmanvel.com).

The efforts come on the heels of a local coronavirus case that was announced Wednesday evening. A Manvel man between the ages of 55 and 65 years old was hospitalized in stable condition after he tested positive.

As part of the staff's two-week effort, residents are encouraged to call, email, pay utilities and fines online or use other communication tools, such as a fax, to do business.

A skeleton crew will be working inside city hall. The limited in-person contact will protect city employees from possible COVID-19 virus transmission. Laptops, conference call software, and other online tools are being used by the staff to work remotely. During this time, the staff will concentrate on high-priority items and projects that require immediate attention.

Police and public works employees will also begin to increase social distancing. For example, during a traffic stop, an officer might write down a driver's license number rather than reach for it. If you need police assistance, please call the Manvel Police Dispatch phone number (281-489-1212).
